

Aga Khan Museum temporarily closed in response to COVID-19

Toronto — Friday, March 13, 2020 — The Aga Khan Museum is temporarily closing its doors to support community efforts to halt the spread of COVID-19. We are tentatively scheduled to reopen on April 7.

The decision to close the Museum was made based upon guidance from public health officials. We continue to monitor the situation closely and will provide ongoing updates to our stakeholders as the situation evolves.

As of Friday, all our scheduled events and programs up to and including April 6 are cancelled. Ticket purchases for affected Museum events, programs, and performances will be automatically refunded by March 20, 2020.

During our closure, community members will have the chance to engage with us online through a curated program of pictures from our collections and videos of past talks and performances.
